**ORDER**

**Dated, 24.11.2009**

The appellant Sri Dilip Laskar is absent without any step. His petition dated 23.11.2009 received by this Commission on the same date is put up today and attached to records.

2. Respondent 1 Smt. Shyamalima Banerjee, Director, State Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development (SIPARD), A.D. Nagar, Agartala and the First Appellate Authority (FAA) is also absent without any step. Respondent 2 Smt. Arpita Chaudhuri, Assistant Professor, SIPARD, A.D. Nagar Agartala and the State Public Information Officer (SPIO) appeared and submitted a written representation, which is attached to records.

3. The case of the appellant is that he made a written request to the SPIO, SIPARD, Agartala on 02.07.2009 seeking certain item of information under the RTI Act, 2005 (for short the Act). In response, the concerned SPIO on 22.07.2009 rejected the written request on the ground that as the investigation is still going on, the information sought for could not be provided and advised the appellant to prefer an appeal before the FAA, SIPARD, Agartala if he has any grievances. Accordingly, on 21.08.2009, the appellant preferred a first appeal before the FAA and the latter directed the SPIO to supply the information after receiving Rs. 8/- as additional fee and the said amount was also deposited by the appellant. Being dissatisfied with the information provided by the concerned SPIO of the SIPARD, Agartala, the appellant preferred this second appeal before



this Commission seeking direction to have access to the full information sought for by him.

4. In her written representation dated 24.11.2009, the Respondent 2 has submitted that though the written request in issue was rejected by her since exempted under section 8(1) of the Act but subsequently, as per direction of the FAA, the Respondent 2 being the SPIO vide her letter No.F.1(193)/Estt/SIPARD/2006/Part-I/1684 dated 07.10.2009 sent by registered post had furnished four pages inquiry report of Sri M.L. Das, Inquiring Authority on the disciplinary proceedings against Sri Nikhil Ch. Das, Driver, SIPARD as sought for by the appellant vide his written request in issue. Respondent 2 has also clarified that the four pages inquiry report furnished to the appellant was not the report of Sri Devanand Reang and also was not four photocopies only of one page of the inquiry report as alleged by the appellant.

5. The appellant vide his petition dated 23.11.2009 has confirmed in writing that he received all the information from the SPIO, SIPARD as sought for by him at his satisfaction and, therefore, he wants to withdraw the second appeal preferred before this Commission on 30.10.2009.

6. The appeal, therefore, stands dropped on withdrawal of the appellant from this second appeal.

7. Let copy of this order be sent to the appellant and the Respondents 1 and 2.
